(Extra lines will be penalised!)

Class 5 Aileen Chapman Trophy - A poem written by a member of the Federation of Women's Institutes of Northern Ireland – Maximum 20 lines

(Extra lines will be penalised!)

Class 6 Downpatrick Trophy - Prepared Prose

- A piece of own choice - Maximum time allowed: TWO minutes
(Extra time will be penalised!)

Copies of pieces for classes 3, 4, 5 & 6 should be attached to entry form, and enclosed with fee of £2.00 per class.

Closing date for entries: Thursday 26th September 2019. Please adhere strictly to the closing date, this is very important in order to give the adjudicator time to read.
