Deramores - Studio DK

1 x 100g Green Tea	Yarn A
1 x 100g Paprika	Yarn B
1 x 100g Gingerbread	Yarn C
1 x 100g Blue Haze	Yarn D
1 x 100g Storm Cloud	Yarn E
1 x 100g Merlot	Yarn F
1 x 100g Shiraz	Yarn G
1 x 100g Butterscotch	Yarn H

Dog uses up to 70g in **Yarn C**, 30g in **Yarn A**, and up to 20g in each of **Yarn H**, **Yarn B**, **Yarn D**, **Yarn E**, **Yarn F** and **Yarn G**.

NEEDLES

3.75mm straight knitting needles (US 5).

SIZE

Approximately 89cm long.

EXTRAS

A darning or tapestry needle.
1 x 250g bag of toy filling.
2 x 9mm safety eyes.

NOTES

Work flat: All pieces are knitted flat (back and forth) on a pair of straight knitting needles.

Tension: The tension is approximately 22 sts x 28 rows for a 10cm x 10cm square in stockinette stitch on 3.75mm needles.

Casting on: Unless otherwise specified, use the long tail cast on for all pieces.

Sewing seams: Use mattress stitch to sew the seams.

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Alt	Alternate.
Beg	Beginning.
Cm	Centimetre.
Foll	Following.
K	Knit.
K2tog	Decrease: Knit two stitches together.
Kfb	Increase: Knit into the front and back of the stitch.
Mm	Millimetre.
P	Purl.
Patt	Pattern
Rep	Repeat.
RS	Right side.

Ssk	Decrease: Slip the next stitch on the left needle knit-wise, then slip the next stitch on the left needle purl-wise. Take the left needle and knit through the front of the two slipped stitches on the right needle. Stitch(es).
St(s)	Stockinette stitch (knit the RS rows and purl the WS rows).
St st	
WS	Wrong side.
[...]	Repeat the sequence between the square brackets by the number indicated.
(.. sts)	The number in round brackets at the end of the instruction indicates the number of stitches after working the row.



Dog Head

Make 1.

Start at the back of the head.

Cast on 9 sts in **Yarn C** on straight 3.75mm needles.

Row 1 and every foll alt row (WS): Purl.

Row 2 (RS): [Kfb] 8 times, k1 (17 sts).

Row 4: [K1, kfb] 8 times, k1 (25 sts).

Row 6: [K2, kfb] 8 times, k1 (33 sts).

Row 8: [K3, kfb] 8 times, k1 (41 sts).

Row 10: [K4, kfb] 8 times, k1 (49 sts).

Row 12: [K5, kfb] 8 times, k1 (57 sts).

Row 14: Knit.

Row 16: [K6, kfb] 8 times, k1 (65 sts).

Rows 17 to 29: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Row 30: K6, [k4, k2tog] x 4, k5, [ssk, k4] x 4, k6 (57 sts).

Row 32: K6, [k3, k2tog] x 4, k5, [ssk, k3] x 4, k6 (49 sts).

Row 34: K6, [k2, k2tog] x 4, k5, [ssk, k2] x 4, k6 (41 sts).

Rows 35 to 39: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Row 40: K16, k2tog, k5, ssk, k16 (39 sts).

Rows 41 to 45: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Row 46: K15, k2tog, k5, ssk, k15 (37 sts).

Rows 47 to 51: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Row 52: K14, k2tog, k5, ssk, k14 (35 sts).

Rows 53 to 55: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Row 56: K13, k2tog, k5, ssk, k13 (33 sts).

Row 58: K1, [k2tog, k2] 8 times (25 sts).

Row 60: K1, [k2tog, k1] 8 times (17 sts).

Row 62: K1, [k2tog] 8 times (9 sts).

Break yarn and thread through rem sts. Pull tight to fasten.

Dog Eyes

Make 2.

Start at the outer edge.

Cast on 25 sts in **Yarn D** on straight 3.75mm needles.

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2 (RS): K1, [k2tog, k1] 8 times (17 sts).

Row 3: Purl.

Row 4: K1, [k2tog] 8 times (9 sts).

Break yarn and thread through rem sts. Pull tight to fasten.

Dog Nose

Make 1.

Start at the outer edge.

Cast on 28 sts in **Yarn F** on straight 3.75mm needles.

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2 (RS): K1, [k2tog, k1] 9 times (19 sts).

Row 3: Purl.

Row 4: K1, [k2tog] 9 times (10 sts).

Break yarn and thread through rem sts. Pull tight to fasten.

Dog Ears

Make 2 in **Yarn A** and make 2 in **Yarn C**.

Cast on 9 sts on straight 3.75mm needles.

Start at the bottom edge.

Row 1 and every foll alt row (WS): Purl.

Row 2 (RS): K1, kfb, knit to the last 2 sts, kfb, k1 (11 sts).

Rows 4, 6 and 8: Rep row 2 three more times (17 sts).

Rows 9 to 19: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Row 20: K1, ssk, knit to the last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 (15 sts).

Rows 21 to 25: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Row 26: Rep row 20 (13 sts).

Rows 27 to 29: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Row 30: Rep row 20 (11 sts).

Rows 31 to 33: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Row 34: Rep row 20 (9 sts).

Row 35: Purl.

Cast off.

Dog Body

Make 1.

Start at the tail end and cast on 9 sts in **Yarn C** on straight 3.75mm needles.

Row 1 and every foll alt row (WS): Purl.

Row 2 (RS): [Kfb] 8 times, k1 (17 sts).

Row 4: [K1, kfb] 8 times, k1 (25 sts).

Row 6: [K2, kfb] 8 times, k1 (33 sts).

Row 8: [K3, kfb] 8 times, k1 (41 sts).

Row 10: Knit.

Row 12: [K4, kfb] 8 times, k1 (49 sts).

Rows 13 to 17: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Break **Yarn C** and join **Yarn D**.

Rows 18 to 30: Beg on a RS knit row, work in st st.

Break **Yarn D** and join **Yarn F**.

Rows 31 to 43: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Break **Yarn F** and join **Yarn A**.

Rows 44 to 56: Beg on a RS knit row, work in st st.

Break **Yarn A** and join **Yarn G**.

Rows 57 to 69: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Break **Yarn G** and join **Yarn H**.

Rows 70 to 82: Beg on a RS knit row, work in st st.

Break **Yarn H** and join **Yarn E**.

Rows 83 to 95: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Break **Yarn E** and join **Yarn B**.

Rows 96 to 108: Beg on a RS knit row, work in st st.

Break **Yarn B** and join **Yarn D**.

Rows 109 to 121: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Break **Yarn D** and join **Yarn F**.

Rows 122 to 134: Beg on a RS knit row, work in st st.

Break **Yarn F** and join **Yarn A**.

Rows 135 to 147: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Break **Yarn A** and join **Yarn G**.

Rows 148 to 160: Beg on a RS knit row, work in st st.

Break **Yarn G** and join **Yarn H**.

Rows 161 to 173: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Break **Yarn H** and join **Yarn E**.

Rows 174 to 186: Beg on a RS knit row, work in st st.

Break **Yarn E** and join **Yarn B**.

Rows 187 to 199: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Break **Yarn B** and join **Yarn C**.

Rows 200 to 205: Beg on a RS knit row, work in st st.

Row 206: [K4, k2tog] 8 times, k1 (41 sts).

Row 208: Knit.

Row 210: [K3, k2tog] 8 times, k1 (33 sts).

Row 212: [K2, k2tog] 8 times, k1 (25 sts).

Row 214: [K1, k2tog] 8 times, k1 (17 sts).

Row 216: [K2tog] 8 times, k1 (9 sts).

Break yarn and thread through rem sts. Pull tight to fasten.

Dog Tail

Make 1.

Start at the base and cast on 16 sts in **Yarn C** on straight 3.75mm needles.

Rows 1 to 13: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Row 14 (RS): K1, [k2tog, k3] 3 times (13 sts).

Rows 15 to 17: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Row 18: K1, [k2tog, k2] 3 times (10 sts).

Row 19: Purl.

Row 20: [K2tog] 5 times (5 sts).

Break yarn and thread through rem sts. Pull tight to fasten.

Dog Legs

Make 4.

Start at the top of the leg.

Cast on 22 sts in **Yarn C** on straight 3.75mm needles.

Rows 1 to 9: Beg on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Row 10 (RS): K1, [k2tog, k1] 7 times (15 sts).

Row 11: Purl.

Row 12: K1, [k2tog] 7 times (8 sts).

Break yarn and thread through rem sts. Pull tight to fasten.

Dog Collar

Make 1.

Cast on 32 sts in **Yarn G** on straight 3.75mm needles.

Rows 1 to 5: Knit.

Cast off.

Making Up

Body: Note that the cast off end is the front. Sew the side edges together, stuffing as you sew, and gather the cast on sts together at the back. The seam runs down centre underside.

Legs: Sew the side edges together, add stuffing, and sew the cast on edge onto the bottom side of the body.

Tail: Sew the side edges together, stuffing as you sew. Sew the cast on edge on the back end of the body.

Head: Note that the cast off end is the nose. Sew the side edges together, stuffing as you sew, and gather the cast on sts together at the back. The seam runs down centre underside.

Eyes: For each piece, sew the side edges together to make a circle shape. Sew on a black button for the pupil, and sew the eye onto the head.

Nose: Sew the side edges together to make a circle shape, and sew onto the front of the head.

Ears: Sew one **Yarn A** piece and one **Yarn C** piece together around the side and cast on edges, and sew the cast off edge onto the top of the head.

Join head and body: Sew the back of the head onto the front of the body.

Collar: Wrap around the neck and sew the side edges together.



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
